Practicum Information

A Child Life Practicum is a pre-internship experience for individuals interested in pursuing a career as a Child Life Specialist. This experience can provide valuable knowledge of evidence-based, developmentally appropriate child life interventions (ACLP 2023). Our practicum program offers a 100 hour in-person clinical experience in which the student will observe and shadow a Certified Child Life Specialist(s) over the course of a semester. Placements are unpaid and housing, transportation, parking expenses, meals, and medical insurance are the responsibility of the student. It is strongly suggested that students have volunteer hours working with children in a hospital setting prior to beginning your practicum clinical hours. Once all applications have been received and reviewed, candidates will be notified if they have moved forward in the process and been selected for an interview. Unfortunately, the submission of an application does not guarantee an interview or placement in our practicum program. Please note that students that complete our child life practicum program may not be considered for future internship placement at our hospital as we encourage students to broaden and diversify their clinical experiences.

Application Requirements

- 1. Current enrollment at an accredited university
- 2. Unofficial transcript
- 3. Minimum of a 3.0 GPA in major courses
- 4. Chart or resume with all relevant volunteer experiences (including sites, dates, and hours)
- 5. 2 letters of reference (one from a professor and one from someone who has observed you work with children)
- 6. Application with completed questionnaire (see page 2)
